## Winter Wheeling—Be Prepared

The club by-laws list mandatory equipment that is needed for any rig to go on a club sanctioned run. Please make certain you have this equipment ready to go. It's for your safety and to make sure everyone has fun on the trail.

### MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

- proper hookups, front and rear.  
**ABSOLUTELY NO TRAILOR BALLS.**
- Proper snatch strap, with no hooks on the ends
- At least one shovel
- Seat belts for all occupants.
- A properly working CB radio
- An operational fire extinguisher.

### RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

- first aid kit
- Spare tire and jack
- Roll bar or cage for soft top vehicles
- Extra food, water, clothing, etc.

### WINTER TRIP RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

- snow shovel
- Sleeping bag
- Heavy/warm clothing
- Adequate snow tires
- Tire chains
- Items for starting a fire

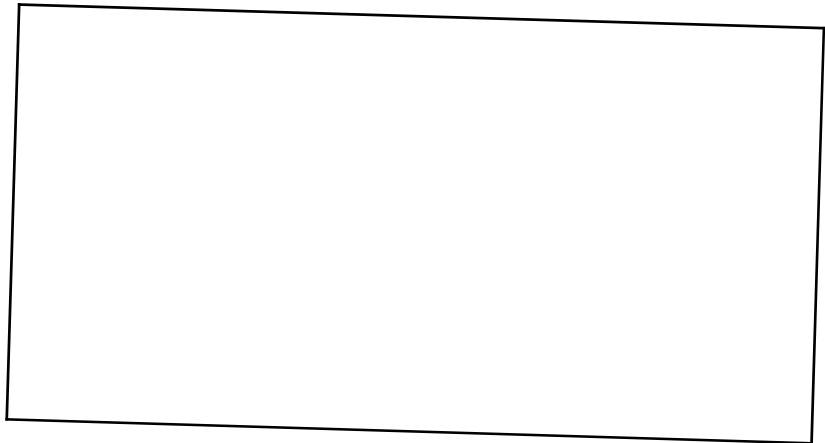
